AGM Presidents Report

The 2018 AGM is upon us, and it is time to reflect back on the last 12 months and look forward to the next 12.

Financially, 2017 was a good year for the Club with a resulting profit of approximately \$30,000. We managed to keep costs static while achieving a lift in revenue of about \$18,000. Some of the revenue items are "once-offs" - such as donations made to purchase a defibrillator – but it is still a strong result. In 2017 there was a lot going on around the Club as usual, but some of the outstanding achievements for us were the following:

- 1. We remained in the top 50 Victorian Tennis Clubs by participation rate. We slipped a little bit from 10 to 13, but when you think that we are in there pitching against Kooyong, Royal South Yarra and Melbourne Park – as well as massive growth centres like Hume and Pakenham – then we are doing very well.
- 2. We acquired a defibrillator after a close call for one of our Tuesday night players. This has been a longstanding goal for the Club and our thanks goes to all who donated funds (Jim Easson, the Wade family, Colin Edwards and the Tuesday night men), organised fund raising and prizes (Dougall McIntyre) and installed the defib unit (Paul Hambleton).
- In terms of Competitions, we are getting stronger. We have added another Tuesday mid-week Ladies team (who made the Finals in their first season and have been promoted), our Monday night team were runners-up in the Spring season, and in the Summer weekend season just finishing we had a record 21 teams across seniors and juniors with 11 of these teams in Finals.

Looking forward, the big project will be the replacement of our courts. Unfortunately they have reached their end of life and are proving too costly and difficult to maintain, and we are being impacted by tree roots and poor drainage as well. At the moment we are deep into a process of sourcing funding, after reviewing different proposals from contractors and selecting a preferred supplier. We have decided to go forward with a premium quality sand-filled synthetic grass. This surface has recently been approved by Tennis Australia and it comes with a number of strong features including being gentler on the knee and ankle joints, being "all weather" and quick drying (less washouts), and it gives us the ability to change the speed of the courts. It is a much fairer surface providing a more true bounce for all styles of play. It is also much cheaper and easier to maintain than the alternatives.

We have also decided to go with a two-tone blue colour to make our courts highly visually appealing from Warrigal Rd and give the appearance of being championship courts.

Finally, a personal "thank you" to our Committee members who are resigning their posts at this AGM: Denese Bacon (who has served our members with distinction for many years), Rosy Interrigi (Secretary) and Jacob Smart (Treasurer). And more "thank you's" to our new Committee members who joined us throughout the year: Catherine Davis, John Wade and Dougall McIntyre.


BALL KIDS 2019 Australian Open

All of Peter's children, Whitney, Jackson and Harrison played for the Burwood Tennis Club throughout their Junior years. The family was well known throughout the club at the time as you could imagine with 3 children of various ages mixing with all aspects of the juniors at that time.

Peter was a loved and loving member of the Sharpe family born in 1960 to Alec and Shirley. He married Wendy in 1990 and they started a family of their own the following year with the birth of their eldest, Whitney, and Jackson and Harrison quickly following. He was extraordinarily proud of his family and they remain equally proud of him.

His battle with mental illness was lengthy, exacerbated by his struggle with his sexuality and the related societal expectations. In recent years he began to accept his sexuality and made several meaningful relationships along the way.

His expectations of himself were too great, especially when it came to aging, work, family, wealth and status. His family considers him a role model in all areas and wishes he could see what they saw. Unfortunately, mental illness is a bigger monster than we understand and he ultimately needed more help than is currently available. Peter has thanked the organisations that have helped him. He is survived by his 3 siblings, Geoff, Ann, and Robert, his wife Wendy, his 3 children, Whitney, Jackson and Harrison, and his daughter-in-law, Maddie. 12/04/1960- 25/01/2018. Forever loved and deeply missed.

The whole Warner family were well known in the area especially with the Warners nursery. The nursery used to be situated across the road from the club, now where there is housing aptly named Nursery Way.

From the Burwood Tennis Club book celebrating 100 years: "Anyone who played Midweek Ladies in the 60s, 70s, 80s or even the 90s would know Shirley Warner such was her incredible longevity.

Shirley was a member of Burwood for 50 years, her name was synonymous with Midweek Ladies. Shirley lived in Donvale and travelled to Burwood for all those years such was her passion for the game, and for Burwood Tennis Club.

Shirley was a strong player, although when I said that to her, she quickly replied...."Iwasn't a good player, I was a dog's body, never had any coaching....just picked it up."
